NEW! Milan Renaissance Art Tour (3 hours)

Meet your expert Art Historian in your hotel lobby for a tour of the Renaissance artworks of Milan. The **Pinacoteca Ambrosiana** is the oldest museum in Milan and dates from 1618. Located in the Ambrosian Library (*Biblioteca Ambrosiana*), it houses a number of notable artworks, including sketches by Raphael for the *School of Athens* mural, which the artist later painted in the Vatican. Also on display are Caravaggio's *Basket of Fruit*, Leonardo da Vinci's *Portrait of a Musician* and Botticelli's *Madonna and Child with Three Angels*.

Next, visit the nearby **Church of S. Maurizio al Monastero Maggiore**, a jewel of Renaissance Lombard art with its unique and fascinating history, filled with colorful frescoes by **Bernardino Luini** (*available on Tues. & Thurs. mornings and Sat. afternoons*). Or, see Michelangelo's marble statue of the **Pietà Rondanini** at the Museum of the Castello Sforzesco upon request.

NEW! A Day on Lake Maggiore (9 hours)

Meet your driver and guide in your Milan hotel lobby at 9:00 a.m. for a day of exploration of Lake Maggiore. **Lake Maggiore** is a magical glacial lake nestled against the mountains and stretching away into Alpine Switzerland. It is here that the famous islands of the Borromeo Gulf including the three Borromeo islands of **Isola Bella, Isola dei Pescatori, and Isola Madre** seem to be painted in one of the most beautiful landscapes of the world.

Isola Bella, with its 17th century Baroque **Borromeo Palace** is populated with white peacocks and adorned with magnificent fountains, grottoes and sculptures, known as a masterpiece of Italian garden design. The palace houses an impressive painting gallery that may be visited from March to October.

The Isola dei Pescatori, or Fisherman's island, is a picturesque village, inhabited by a small community that still makes its living by fishing. The Isola Madre is a virtual botanical garden on water. Abounding in rare plants and exotic flowers, the favourable microclimate has helped to create an enchanting tropical green house. After the islands tour, the last stop will be at the charming resort town of **Stresa**. Located just across the waters from the Borromeo islands, this international tourist resort attracts visitors from all over the world, with its elegant villas, plush gardens, wonderful restaurants, hotels and stylish boutiques.

Venice Private Transfers

Boat Transfers include one piece of luggage per person with a €3 charge for each additional piece paid directly to the assistant. An additional 25 percent is added for transfers from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. A total of €40 will be added to cost of arrivals delayed more than 45 minutes at the train station or Piazzale Roma. No charge is applied for delayed original flights. **Please note that in the event of weather or strong tides, clients may not be unable to access the dock closest to their hotel.** If clients opt for a Deluxe Transfer, the assistant will attempt to request portage from the hotel. Due to union rules, assistants are not allowed to handle luggage and in this instance, clients may have to transport luggage to the hotel entrance themselves.

Please note that on the following days in Venice in 2011 there will be transportation issues due to local events: May 27, June 2, July 14 & 15, Sep 4 and we will advise accordingly of possible modifications to transfers. The America's Cup is due to be held in Venice from May 12-20 and may contribute to transfer delays.

Standard Private Boat Transfers

Standard arrival airport transfer includes portage, transfer in comfortable minivan or taxi from airport to private boat, and transfer to the closest dock to the hotel. **Standard arrival transfer from train station** includes portage and transfer by private boat to the closest dock to the hotel. Luggage transfer from arrival dock to the hotel is not included.

Standard Departure transfer includes a greeting by an assistant in hotel lobby and transfer in a private boat to the airport or train station. Portage is not included, although this service may be available for hire at the airport and train station. For airport departures, clients will need to make their way independently to the terminal.

Deluxe Private Boat Transfers

Deluxe arrival transfers include an assistant upon arrival at the airport or train station to accompany guests to the private boat and coordinate portage and ends with hotel check-in. Portage included to airport, train station, and the Piazzale Roma dock in Venice. An assistant will secure a city porter for hotels without their own dock when possible. This service is paid to the porter directly.

Deluxe departure transfers include an assistant from departure from hotel lobby, transfer by a private boat to the airport, train station, or port to the check-in area. For airport departures, clients will transfer to required terminal by private car or comfortable minivan. Portage is included from dock in Venice to airport check-in counter or train track. An assistant will attempt to secure a city porter for hotels without their own dock. This service is paid to the porter directly. For departures by train, an assistant will take clients to appropriate platform while a porter arrives with luggage.

Train stations: Driver will be found at the head of the track bearing a sign with the client's last name.

Ports: Driver will be found in the main Arrivals area with a sign bearing the client's last name; they cannot arrive at the gangplank/exit stairs.

Transfer Details for Departures:

Airports: Service is to curbside as close as possible to client's entry point. Extra VIP assistance and portage is able to be booked at extra cost at the Rome airport.

Train stations: Service is to curbside as close as possible to client's entry point. Extra VIP assistance and portage is able to be booked at extra cost at the Rome station.

Late Arrivals: Clients who miss their transfer or see that their plane, train or ship will not arrive at the scheduled time need to notify our office ahead of time so that we can attempt to reschedule their transfer. Every attempt will be made to modify the time of the transfer; but in some cases it may be necessary to book a new driver and in that case an additional fee will be charged.
